**SUMMARY OF REPORTED PROBLEMS  
PRIMARY ELECTION - MAY 12, 1998**

**Lower Platte South Natural Resource District-At Large**

Voters in two precincts in Saunders County failed to receive ballots for Lower Platte South NRD in the subdistrict five and at large races. Error discovered and corrected at approximately 5:00 PM on election day. Number of voters impacted is 501.

In subdistrict 5 the margin between second and third place is 1035 votes and the error would not have impacted the outcome.

In the at large race, the margin between second and third place was 137 votes and the voters who did not receive ballots could have altered the outcome.

At the request of a Canvass Board member, the third place candidate, Stephen Mills was contacted for comments on the situation. He was unaware of the problem. He had worked in the Ceresco area for 3 ½ years until last October, and felt that Saunders County was a strong area for him. Felt the error had impacted the outcome of the election but was not interested in spending a lot of money contesting the election.

Additional information has been submitted by the Saunders County Clerk to the Canvassing Board.

**North Platte Natural Resource District-Subdistrict One**

Voters in the counties of Banner, Morrill, and Garden failed to receive ballots for North Platte NRD Subdistrict One. Error was discovered and corrected at approximately 1:00 PM on election day. Number of voters impacted is Banner 147, Morrill 522, and Garden 321 for a total of 990 votes. There was no error in the remaining two counties within the NRD, Sioux and Scotts Bluff.

The margin between second and third place was 137 votes, between second and fourth was 152 votes and between second and fifth was 487 votes. As a result the error could have altered the outcome.

The error was caused by a miscommunication between the NRD and the Secretary of State's office. While the certification for Subdistrict one did have the box checked to indicate that it was an at-large race, the portion describing the areas that should receive ballots did not contain the entire district. In addition, the error was not noticed when the copies of counties' notice of election were provided to the candidates and the NRD.

At the request of a Canvass Board member, the candidates in third, fourth and fifth place were contacted. Steven Dollberg (third place) indicated that he did not particularly care, was content with the quality of the candidates who had finished in first and second place, and was not particularly strong in the areas where the errors had occurred. He declined the opportunity to provide the Canvassing Board with a written statement.

Doyle Nickerson (fourth place) was contacted and asked for a day to think about the situation. When later contacted, he did not have any comment to be added.

Mick Lookabill (fifth place) indicated that he did not feel that it was a big deal one way or the other and felt that the two candidates who had received the most votes should receive the nomination. He also declined the opportunity to provide a written statement.

**Papio Missouri Natural Resource District, Subdistrict Eight**

Voters in one precinct failed to receive ballots for the subdistrict eight race affecting 104 voters. The margin between second and third place was 73 votes and the error could have impacted the outcome. The error was caused by pollworkers failing to provide the ballot, although available, to the impacted voters. The Douglas County Election Commissioner has provided additional information for the Canvassing Board. At the request of a Canvassing Board member, the candidate in third place was contacted. Kevin Doyle indicated that he would submit written comments.
