DAWES COUNTY

Dawes County is a part of public service commission district 5. On the Democratic ballot the county clerk used candidates from district 4 on the ballots. Page 9 carries no returns from Dawes County. The 5th district was an uncontested seat so the omission of the name of the republican candidate didn't affect the nomination of a candidate.

PHELPS COUNTY

Phelps County left the name of the 5th district Public Service Commissioner off both the Republican and Democratic ballots. Page 9 carries no returns from Phelps County. The 5th District was uncontested on both the Republican and Democratic ballots so the omission of the names of the candidates didn't affect the nomination of either candidate.

HOWARD COUNTY AND KNOX COUNTY

Left name of the 6th district Board of Regent off the ballot. Page 28 carries no returns from Howard or Knox counties. The 6th district was an uncontested seat so the omission of the name of the candidate didn't affect the nomination of a candidate.

KIMBALL COUNTY

Left the name of the at large candidate for Western Community College off the ballot. Page 32 carries no returns from Kimball county. The at large seat was an uncontested seat so the omission of the name of the candidate didn't affect the nomination of a candidate.

JOHNSON COUNTY

Left name of the at large candidate Southeast Community College off the ballot. Page 31 carries no returns from Johnson county. The at large seat was an uncontested seat so the omission of the name of the candidate didn't affect the nomination of a candidate.

DOUGLAS COUNTY

The returns for Metropolitan Community College district 5 were not counted. Page 30 carries no returns for district 5 Douglas county. The two candidates move forward to the general election. A full explanation of the reason ballots were not counted will have to come from the records of the Douglas county election commissioner's office.
